FOLLOWING THE STUDENT CONTRACT IS PART OF YOUR ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR MESA CCP

Please read the contract through, in order to fully understand what will be expected of you as an active HP-MESA student.

Keeping this agreement will result in greatly increasing your success of transferring to a four-year campus. Failure to comply can result in 1) MESA not paying your way to campus visits and/or leadership conferences, 2) MESA not providing direct and/or indirect support to you, and 3) you being dropped from the HP-MESA program.

As a Darton College HP-MESA student, I agree to:

- Actively participate in the HP-MESA Diversity in Engineering Study Center several times a week (a minimum of 5 hours) or studying with other HP-MESA students, and attending HP-MESA activities such as workshops, field trips, leadership retreats, conferences, and other events as my schedule permits
- Strive to promote my own academic and personal success by actively participating in my classes and serving as a good role-model for other students.
- Meet with my HP-MESA Director/Counselor each semester and maintain a complete Education Plan (from current semester through transfer)
- Contact my HP-MESA Director/Counselor at the first sign of a poor grade, or problems or trouble related to school, home, finances, etc.
- Whenever possible, take math, engineering, and/or science classes with other HP-MESA students
- Participate in Academic Excellence Workshops if they are offered for a class in which I am enrolled and as my schedule permits
- Check-in with the HP-MESA Director/Counselor at least twice per semester

As the HP-MESA Director/Counselor, I agree to:

- Listen to your concerns and needs, and support you with respect and regard
- Provide timely and correct information to you, and to help you succeed academically, professionally, and personally
- Monitor your academic progress and make recommendations as needed
