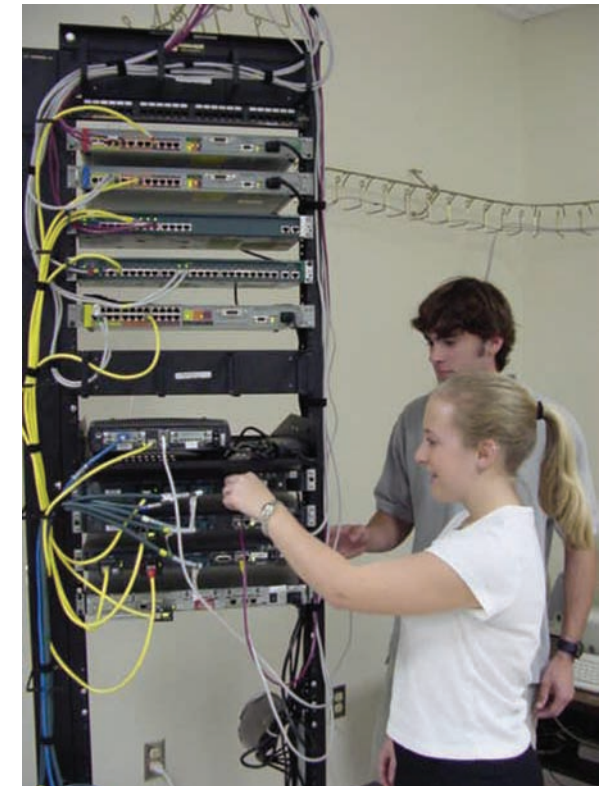

Cisco Certification

Darton College is an approved Cisco Networking Academy. Two programs are offered: A one-year Cisco Support Specialist Certificate option and a two-year Associate of Applied Science Cisco Support Specialist option. Both programs are designed to prepare students to become entry-level technicians with skills to install, configure, support, and troubleshoot Cisco routers and switches in a small to medium business environment.

The Cisco Networking Academy Program is a comprehensive e-learning program that provides students with the Internet technology skills essential in a global economy. The Networking Academy delivers Web-based content, online assessment, student performance tracking, hands-on labs, instructor led training and support, and preparation for industry standard certifications.

Darton students who complete the program may take the following certification examinations:

- Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA)
- CompTIA A+, Security+, Linux+



Cisco One-Year Certificate Option

The CCNA is the first of two certifications (the second - Cisco Certified Networking Professional - CCNP) on the path toward Cisco Certified Internetwork Expert (CCIE) status, the industry's most respected networking certification.

The two computer system support classes give the basic knowledge and skills to become an entry-level computer technician, while the Security course will provide students with the basic concepts and terminology and know-how to secure a small to medium size network. The four Cisco courses provide a basic understanding of Cisco networking, utilizing Cisco routers and switches. In addition, the UNIX course will give students exposure to an operating system typically found in networking environments.

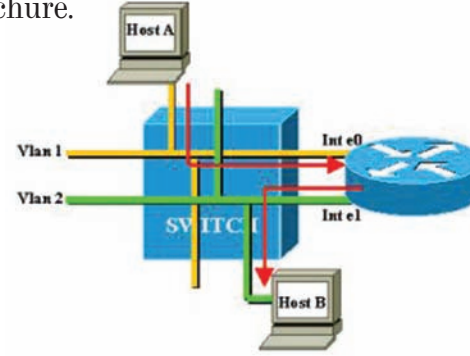

Students who complete the certificate option may add courses to earn the Cisco Support Specialist Associate of Applied Science degree. The requirements for this program are listed on the back of the brochure.

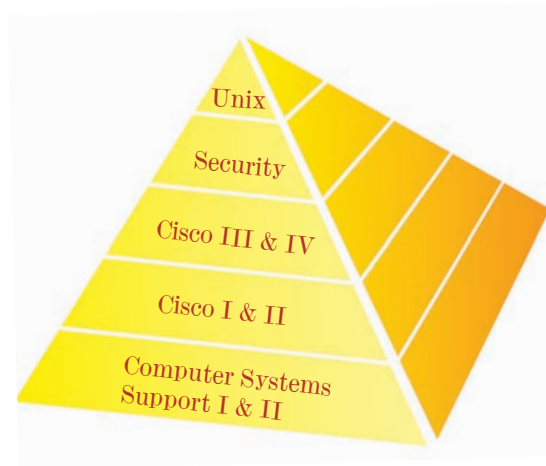


Cisco Certification Employment Outlook
