No applications will be accepted after the deadline.

ADMISSION TO THE NURSING PROGRAM:

Minimum admission standards include:

1. Unconditional admission to Darton College.
2. Are active military, military family or civilian employee of the Ft. Benning US Army Post in Ft. Benning, GA.
3. Hold current certificate for Paramedic, License for LPN or Army Medic (Classification 68WM6) (attach copy of license) with one (1) year of continuous work experience.
4. Receipt of completed application for the ADN program by the semester deadline.
5. Exit all required remedial courses.
6. Have earned credit on 16 or more credit hours of the general education courses required for the Darton College Nursing program (Anatomy & Physiology I, II, English 1101 and Medical Terminology recommended – preference will be given to those who have completed both A&P I and II).
7. Minimum of 2.7 GPA based on each attempt of credit hours for general education courses required for the Darton College Nursing program including transferred GPA from other colleges.
8. Evidence of prior learning in an on-line format.
9. No previous failing grades in other nursing programs
10. Submission of a written essay documenting your on-line learning experiences and your reason for choosing a career in nursing. Please attach to this application (1-2 pages double-spaced)
11. Completion of the HESI Admission Assessment (A2) Exam.
12. Meet core performance standards for admission and progression in the nursing program.

Admission to the nursing program is competitive, and the number of students is limited by the number of faculty and clinical facilities available. Meeting minimal requirements does not guarantee acceptance.

When faculty/student ratio limits the acceptance of all qualified students, preference will be given to students with the highest GPA and highest nursing pre-admission test score and have completed all required core classes.

HESI Admission Assessment Exam (A2)

Completion of the HESI Admission Assessment Exam (A2) is required to be considered for admission to the Darton Nursing Program. This test will evaluate your performance in math, reading comprehension, vocabulary, grammar and anatomy and physiology.

A review guide for the HESI Admission Assessment Exam (A2) the *Evolve Reach Testing and Remediation Admission Assessment Exam Review, 2nd Edition ISBN 978-1-4160-5635-5* is available for purchase in the Darton bookstore and is also available online.

Your score on this test will be considered along with your **college GPA** and number of core courses completed when determining your acceptance status.

Make sure you meet the requirements for admission to the nursing program prior to submitting your application. If you do not meet the minimum eligibility requirements, you cannot be considered for admission to the nursing program even if you have taken the Admission Assessment Exam.

This is a computerized test; 5 hours will be allowed for testing. The test must be taken in Ft. Benning – location, dates and times to be announced.

- Arrive by your assigned time– Late arrivals will not be guaranteed admission to testing and will not be allowed extended time to complete the test.
- In order to test you **must have** – photo identification (driver’s license or school ID) and valid email address

DO NOT BRING:

- Cell phones – phone calls are not allowed during testing.
- Food & drinks. There are no food breaks.
- Calculators. Use is *prohibited* during test.

You will be contacted with a choice of testing dates after the June 15, 2012 deadline.
